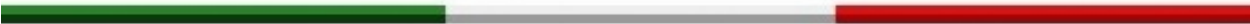
THE PRODUCTION OF THE SELF: CONVERSATIONS ABOUT MARISA MERZ









FREE PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT WORKSHOP - PRE-K TO AP - FOR TEACHERS OF ITALIAN
